



DRCC We-Consent Research 2024

In 2024, questions were included in an omnibus survey undertaken by Opinions Research amongst a nationally representative sample of the population.

- Sample size of 823 adults (193 skipped once they were made aware of the survey content – which is within normal range for a topic of this type).
- Quota controls were applied on Sex, Age, Social Grade and Region.
- Fieldwork conducted from 23rd – 26th January 2024.

Almost half of those surveyed reported that they have a more positive attitude towards consent now than they did 12 months ago

Almost half of those surveyed reported a better understanding of consent than they held 12 months ago

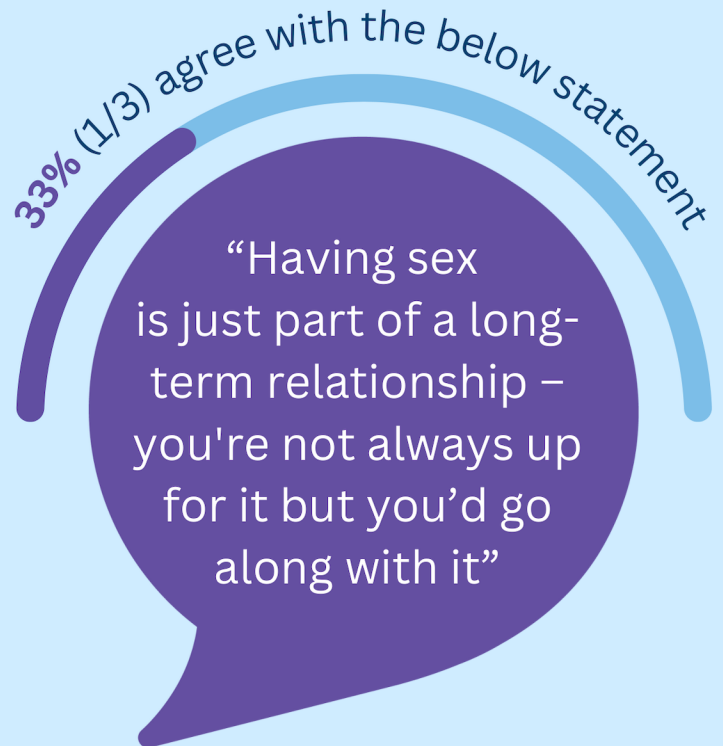
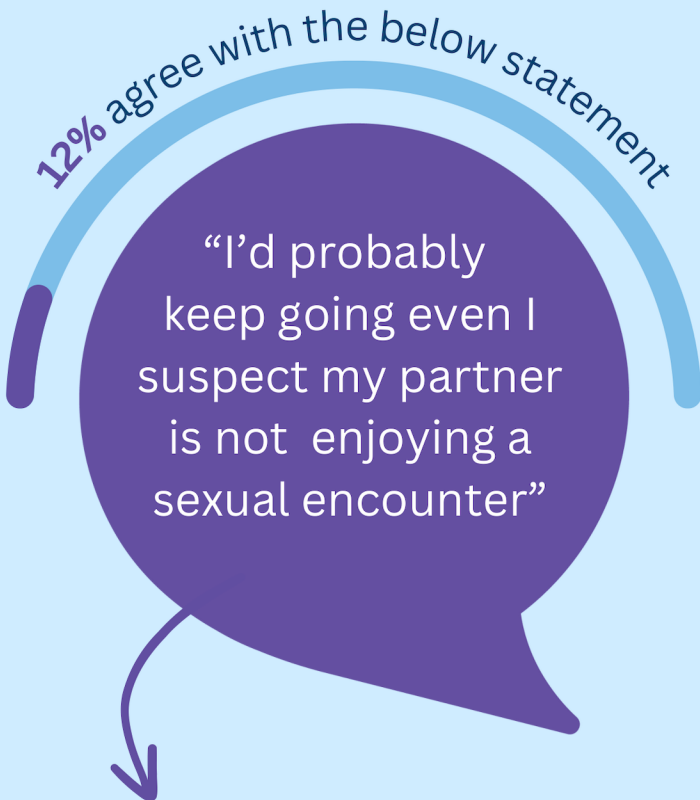
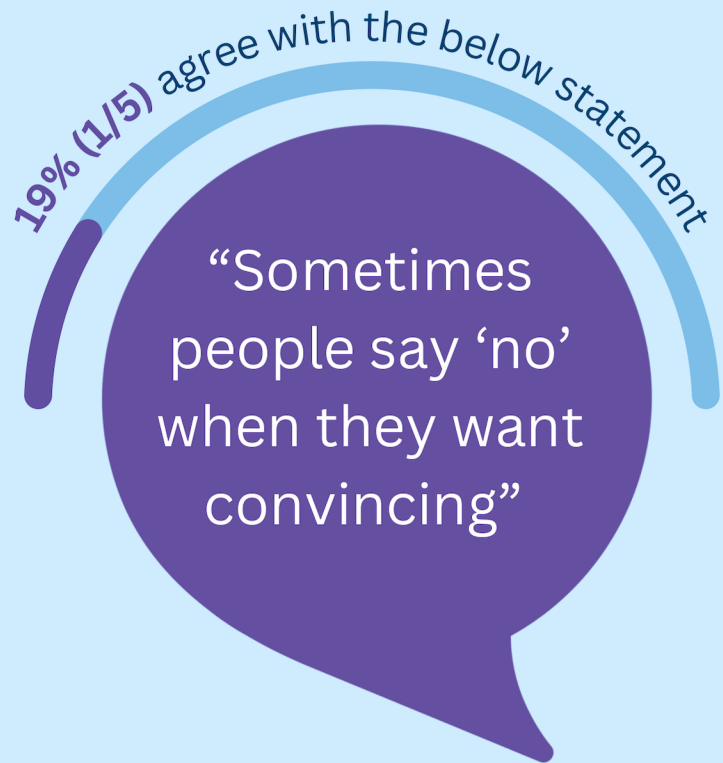
agree that sexual activity is consensual when each person is willing all of the time
